1. In view of the continuing COVID-19 pandemic, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (“MCA”) vide its Circular nos. 10-11/2022 dated 28th December, 2022 read with Circular no. 14/2020 dated 8th April 2020, 17/2020 dated 13th April 2020, 20/2020 dated 5th May 2020, 22/2020 dated 15th June 2020, 33/2020 dated 28th September 2020, 39/2020 dated 31st December 2020, 02/2021 dated 13th January, 2021, 10/2021 dated 23rd June, 2021, 20-21/2021 dated 8th December, 2021 and 14th December, 2021, 2-3 dated 05.05.2022, issued by Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) has permitted Companies to hold the Extra-Ordinary General Meeting (“EOGM”) through Video Conferencing (“VC”) or Other Audio-Visual Means (“OAVM”).
2. The relevant Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102(1) of the Companies Act, 2013, in respect of the special item as set out in the Notice is annexed hereto. Since the EOGM is held by VC/OAVM, the said special business is being considered unavoidable and therefore proposed to be transacted at the EOGM of the Company.
3. Pursuant to the Circular No. 14/2020 dated 8th April, 2020, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, the facility to appoint proxy to attend and cast vote for the members is not available for this EOGM. However, the Body Corporates are entitled to appoint authorized representatives to attend the EOGM through VC/OAVM and participate thereat and cast their votes through e-voting.
4. The attendance of the Members attending the EOGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.
5. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended), and the Circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs dated 8th April, 2020, 13th April, 2020 and 5th May, 2020 the Company is providing facility of remote e-Voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the EOGM. For this purpose, the Company has approached the Registrar and Share Transfer Agent, Bigshare Services Private Limited for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized agency. The facility of casting votes by a member using remote e-Voting system will be provided by Bigshare Services Private Limited.
6. In line with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) Circular No. 17/2020 dated 13th April, 2020, the Notice calling the EOGM has been uploaded on the website of the Company at www.amiablelogistics.in. The Notice can also be accessed from the website of the National Stock Exchange of India Limited at www.nseindia.com.
7. EOGM shall be convened through VC/OAVM in compliance with applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the circulars thereto.

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8. Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 (“the Act”) setting out material facts concerning the special business of the accompanying Notice, is annexed hereto.
9. M/s K. C. Suthar & Co., Practising Company Secretary, of Mumbai, (Membership No. F5191) and Certificate of Practice No 4075 has been appointed as the scrutinizer to scrutinize the voting and remote e-voting process in fair and transparent manner.

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Bigshare i-Vote E-Voting System

THE INTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING ARE AS UNDER:

- i. The voting period begins on Monday, 22nd May, 2023 at 09:00 AM and ends on Wednesday, 24th May, 2023 at 05:00 PM. During this period shareholders' of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of Thursday, 18th May, 2023 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by Bigshare for voting thereafter.
- ii. Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.
- iii. Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants**. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

- iv. In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

1. Pursuant to above said SEBI Circular, Login method for e-Voting and joining virtual meetings for **Individual shareholders holding securities in Demat mode** is given below:

2. **Login method for e-Voting for shareholder other than individual shareholders holding shares in Demat mode & physical mode is given below:**

- You are requested to launch the URL on internet browser: <https://ivote.bigshareonline.com>
- Click on “LOGIN” button under the ‘INVESTOR LOGIN’ section to Login on E-Voting Platform.
- Please enter you ‘USER ID’ (User id description is given below) and ‘PASSWORD’ which is shared separately on you register email id.
 - Shareholders holding shares in CDSL demat account should enter 16 Digit Beneficiary ID as user id.

- Once you confirm the vote you will receive confirmation message on display screen and also you will receive an email on your registered email id. During the voting period, members can login any number of times till they have voted on the resolution(s). Once vote on a resolution is casted, it cannot be changed subsequently.
- Shareholder can "**CHANGE PASSWORD**" or "**VIEW/UPDATE PROFILE**" under "**PROFILE**" option on investor portal.

3. Custodian registration process for i-Vote E-Voting Website:

- Click on "**REGISTER**" under "**CUSTODIAN LOGIN**", to register yourself on Bigshare i-Vote e-Voting Platform.
- Enter all required details and submit.

- After Successful registration, message will be displayed with **“User id and password will be sent via email on your registered email id”**.

NOTE: If Custodian have registered on to e-Voting system of <https://ivote.bigshareonline.com> and/or voted on an earlier event of any company then they can use their existing user id and password to login.

 - Click on upload document **“CHOOSE FILE”** and upload power of attorney (POA) or board resolution for respective investor and click on **“UPLOAD”**.

Note: The power of attorney (POA) or board resolution has to be named as the **“InvestorID.pdf”** (Mention Demat account number as Investor ID.)

 - Your investor is now mapped and you can check the file status on display.

Investor vote File Upload:

- To cast your vote select **“VOTE FILE UPLOAD”** option from left hand side menu on custodian portal.
- Select the Event under dropdown option.
- Download sample voting file and enter relevant details as required and upload the same file under upload document option by clicking on **“UPLOAD”**. Confirmation message will be displayed on the screen and also you can check the file status on display (Once vote on a resolution is casted, it cannot be changed subsequently).
- Custodian can **“CHANGE PASSWORD”** or **“VIEW/UPDATE PROFILE”** under **“PROFILE”** option on custodian portal.

4. Procedure for joining the AGM/EOGM through VC/ OAVM:

For shareholder other than individual shareholders holding shares in Demat mode & physical mode is given below:

- The Members may attend the AGM through VC/ OAVM at <https://ivote.bigshareonline.com> under Investor login by using the e-voting credentials (i.e., User ID and Password).
- After successful login, **Bigshare E-voting system** page will appear.
- Click on “**VIEW EVENT DETAILS (CURRENT)**” under ‘EVENTS’ option on investor portal.
- Select event for which you are desire to attend the AGM/EOGM under the dropdown option.
- For joining virtual meeting, you need to click on “VC/OAVM” link placed beside of “**VIDEO CONFERENCE LINK**” option.
- Members attending the AGM/EOGM through VC/ OAVM will be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.

The instructions for Members for e-voting on the day of the AGM/EOGM are as under:-

- The Members can join the AGM/EOGM in the VC/ OAVM mode 15 minutes before the scheduled time of the commencement of the meeting. The procedure for e-voting on the day of the AGM/EOGM is same as the instructions mentioned above for remote e-voting.
- Only those members/shareholders, who will be present in the AGM/EOGM through VC/OAVM facility and have not casted their vote on the Resolutions through remote e-Voting and are otherwise not barred from doing so, shall be eligible to vote through e-Voting system in the AGM/EOGM.
- Members who have voted through Remote e-Voting will be eligible to attend the EOGM. However, they will not be eligible to vote at the AGM/EOGM.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013

M/s. P. V. Jain & Co., Chartered Accountants were appointed as Statutory Auditors of the Company by the members at their Annual General Meeting held on 30th November, 2021 for a term of 5 years for the Financial Years 2021-22 to 2025-26 for conducting audit in terms of Section 139 and 141 of the Companies Act, 2013, and Rule 4 of the Companies (Audit and Auditors) Rules, 2014.

However, the company has listed its equity shares with the National Stock Exchange in November, 2022. As per Regulation 33 (1) (d) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements), 2015, the limited review/ audit report submitted to the Stock Exchange shall be given only by an auditor who has subjected himself /herself to the peer review process of Institute of Chartered Accountants of India and holds a valid certificate issued by the Peer Review Board of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

The Board has decided to comply with the abovementioned regulation by replacing the existing Statutory Auditors' Firm with the Chartered Accountants that holds a valid certificate issued by the Peer Review Board of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

This has resulted into a casual vacancy in the office of Statutory Auditors of the Company as envisaged by Section 139(8) of the Companies Act, 2013. Casual vacancy caused by the resignation of auditor shall be approved by the shareholders in General Meeting within three months from the date of recommendation of the Board of Directors of the Company. The Board of Directors of the Company recommended the appointment of M/s. AHJ & Associates, Chartered Accountants (Firm Registration No. 151685W), a peer reviewed firm, as the Statutory Auditors of the Company to fill the casual vacancy caused by the resignation of M/s P. V. Jain & Co. Accordingly, shareholders' approval by way of ordinary resolution is sought.

The Company hereby informs that on the basis of recommendation of the Audit Committee, the Board of Directors, at its meeting held today i.e. on 1st May, 2023, has approved the appointment of M/s. AHJ & Associates, Chartered Accountants, (Firm Registration No. 151685W), a peer reviewed firm, in place of the retiring auditors M/s. P. V. Jain & Co., Chartered Accountants, Mumbai, (Firm Registration No. 0157500W), a peer reviewed firm and recommended for share-holders' approval at the Extra-Ordinary General Meeting scheduled to be held on Thursday, 25th May, 2023.

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M/s. AHJ & Associates, Chartered Accountants, (Firm Registration No. 151685W), have conveyed their consent for being appointed as the Statutory Auditors of the Company along with a confirmation that, their appointment, if made by the members, would be within the limits prescribed under the Companies Act, 2013 and shall satisfy the criteria as provided under section 141 of the Companies Act, 2013 and have given a certificate in prescribed form declaring that firm complies with all eligibility norms prescribed by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs regarding appointment of statutory auditors.

The Board of Directors of the Company recommends the passing of the resolution in of the notice as an ordinary resolution.

None of the Directors or Key Managerial Persons of the Company (including their relatives), except to the extent of their shareholding in the Company are concerned or interested in the said resolution.
